



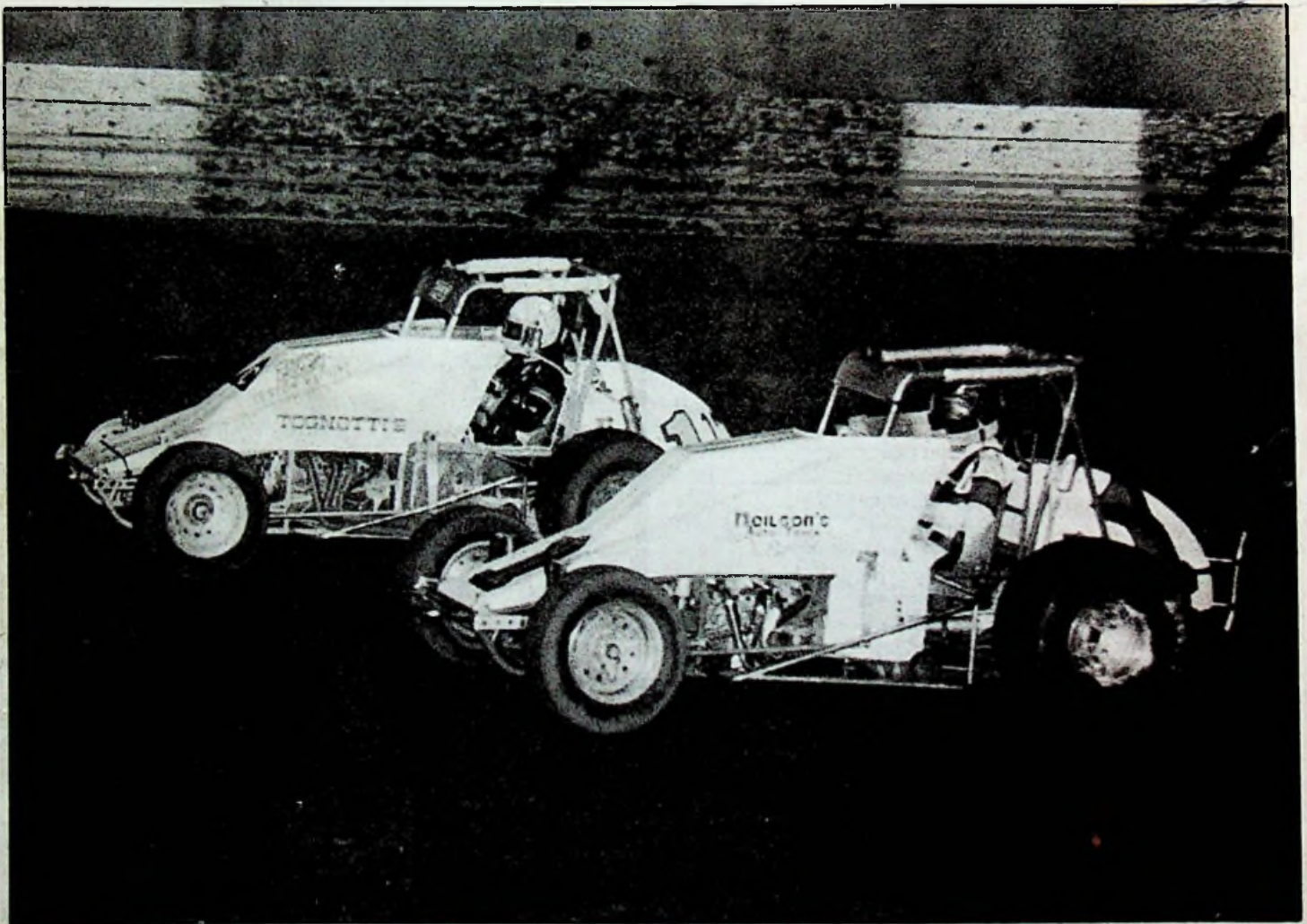

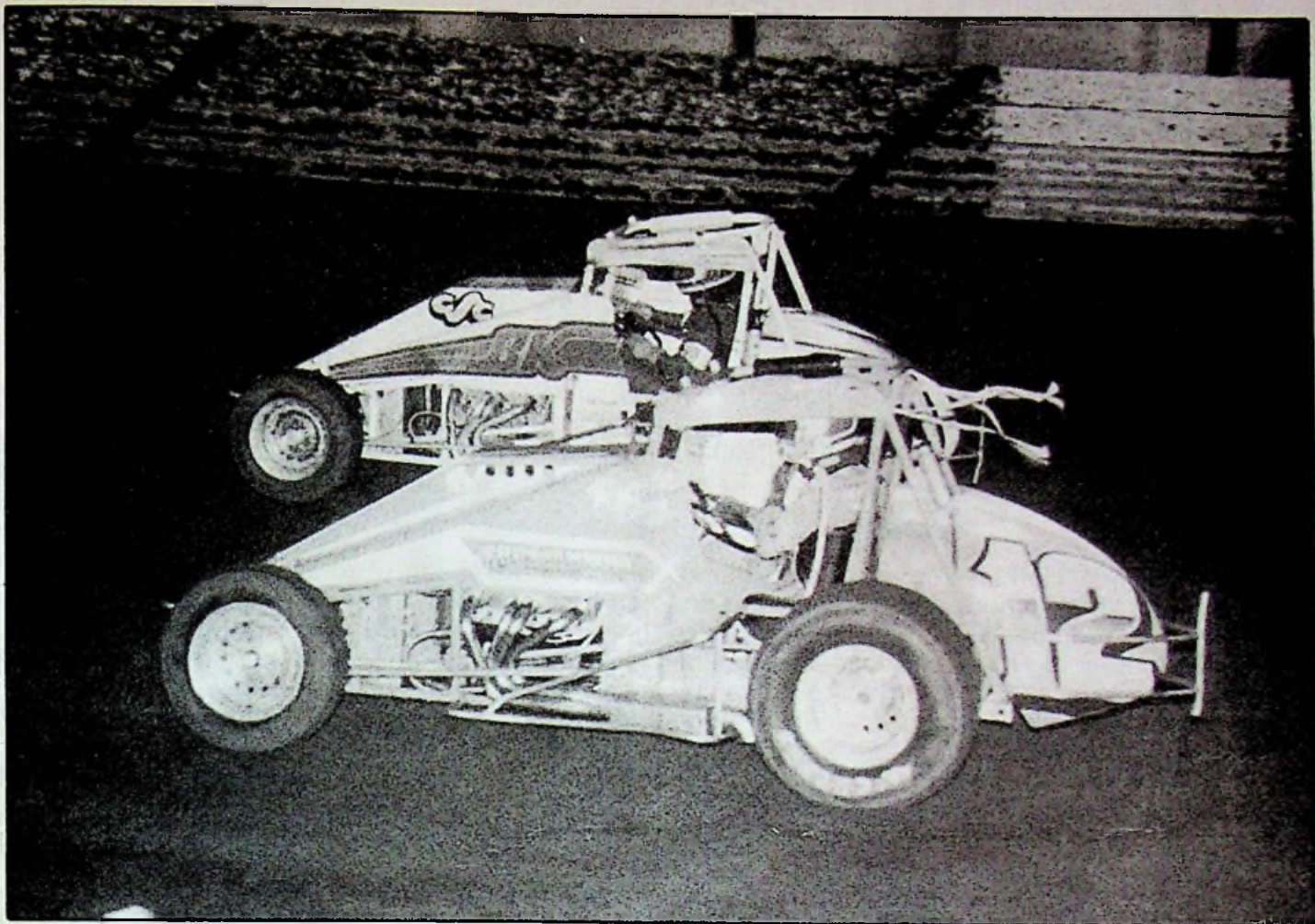

It's Miller Time!

WELCOME Race Fans to this Fourth of July Weekend's NARC-Miller High Life Sprint Car races at the Napa Fairgrounds. Fair Manager Mike Kinney and his Board of Directors as well as NARC President Louie Vermeil hope in addition to enjoying the exciting sprint car races you take time and come early and enjoy the Fair!

THESE two annual Holiday Weekend races mark the start of the second half of the NARC-Miller High Life Championship Point Series. Through the first half of the season almost all Sprint Car fans know how hot Brent "Campbell Comet" Kaeding has been. Here are some facts to back it up! Through the first 12 races Kaeding has won nine of them, finished 2nd once, 3rd once and one did not finish. He has already tied the NARC record for most wins in a season held jointly by three drivers - Chuck Gurney, Jim Sills and Mike Andretta - and Kaeding still has 16 races left this year to break that record! Kaeding by virtue of his nine Main Event Wins has jumped from 15th to 7th on the All Time List needing only three more wins to surpass Sills, Johnny Anderson and the late Gary Patterson for 4th and six wins to tie Jimmy Boyd for 3rd. Only LeRoy Van Conett with 65 and Chuck Gurney with 29 seem out of Kaedings reach.

ANOTHER driver to reckon with here at Calistoga and on the NARC-Miller circuit is 1984 Baylands Sprint Car Champ, now racing full time with NARC, Roseville's Dave Bradway, Jr. Bradway, Jr. stopped Kaeding's three race win streak at Calistoga in 1985 with a convincing wire to wire win at Calistoga on June 22. The elder Bradway racing brother, since he began racing full time with the NARC-Miller series six weeks ago, has won twice (here and in Chico, May 18). Dave also has a 2nd, 4th and 5th place feature finish in six races.

IT was nice to see 1984 NARC-Miller Rookie of the Year Shane Scott back in the saddle again. Scott started the year without a ride, incredibly enough, finally landed a good one by hooking up with the Yuba City Scrap and Steel boys Rich and Ron Lovell in their Bud Light Special recently vacated by Jimmy Sills. Scott won a couple of non-NARC shows at Chico and on June 22 got his highest NARC-Miller finish of the year coming home 2nd behind Dave Bradway and beating Kaeding. Look for this newly formed team to crack the winners circle soon.

DAVE Bradway, Jr. of Roseville continued his hot streak he's been on lately by capturing both Main Events at Hanford and Santa Maria this past weekend. Bradway beat Rick Ungar and Brent Kaeding Friday and decisioned Kaeding and Rich Forsberg on Saturday.
