RACE NIGHT GLOSSARY

A-Main (or Feature) – The final race of the night which decides who is the over-all winner of the event. Depending on the size of the track the A-Main usually ranges from 25-40 laps, which is predetermined and shared with the drivers and teams at the drivers meeting.

B-Main (Last Chance Showdown) – This is the final chance a driver to make it into the A-Main. Depending on the number of heat races run, the top 4 (or in some cases more) finishers in the B-Main will transfer into the main event. The B-Main is 12 laps in length.

Dash – The first and second place finishers from each of the four heat races, in a standard race program, qualify for the dash. These eight cars will randomly draw for their starting position in the dash (Positions 1-8). The 9th and 10th place starters in the dash will be the two fastest cars from time trials that did not finish first or second in their heat, but transferred through the heat race into the A-Feature. The Top-10 starting positions in the A-Feature are then determined by the finishing order of the dash.

Drivers Meeting – Prior to each night of racing, all World of Outlaws drivers and crew members attend a mandatory meeting, which is conducted by the World of Outlaws Competition Director and Series Officials. The meetings outlines the night's racing events and any procedural changes that may be in place.

Hot Laps – A session held prior to time trials. This session is run in groups. Each car is assigned to a group prior to this hot lap session, and the groups are determined by the draw that set the order for time trials. During this practice session each car is allotted 3 or more laps (the number depends on the size of the track) at speed in order to ensure that their car is ready for qualifying.

Heat Race (or Heat) – An 8-10 lap race (the distance is determined by the size of the track) that determines which cars will move on to the A-Feature or B Main. The top five cars in the heats transfer to the A-Main, when there are four heat races.

Inversion – The Top-16 cars in time trials are inverted in the heat races, meaning that the fastest qualifier in time trials starts in the fourth-spot in the first heat. The second fastest qualifier starts in the fourth-spot of the second heat. The third fastest qualifier starts in the fourth spot in the third heat, and

the fourth quick qualifier starts in the fourth spot in the fourth heat (when four heats are run). The fifth fastest qualifier starts third in the first heat. The sixth fastest qualifier starts third in the second heat, and so on, working up to the 13th fastest qualifier starting on the pole of the first heat. The 14th fastest qualifier is on the pole of the second heat. The 15th fastest qualifier is on the pole for the third heat. The 16th fastest qualifier is on the pole of the fourth heat (See layout below). The remainder of the cars are lined up heads up by their time, starting in the third row of each heat race. The 17th fastest car in qualifying lines up fifth in the first heat, with the 18th fastest qualifier, fifth in the second heat, and so on until the rest of the field is filled.

Time Trials – Each competitor is given two timed laps to determine where they will start in a heat race. In 2008, if more than 40 cars are present at an event, single-lap qualifying will be utilized. If a competitor misses their spot in the qualifying order by more than two places, by rule, they are allowed one lap at the end of time trials and the best they can be is 17th or 1 spot behind the inversion cars.

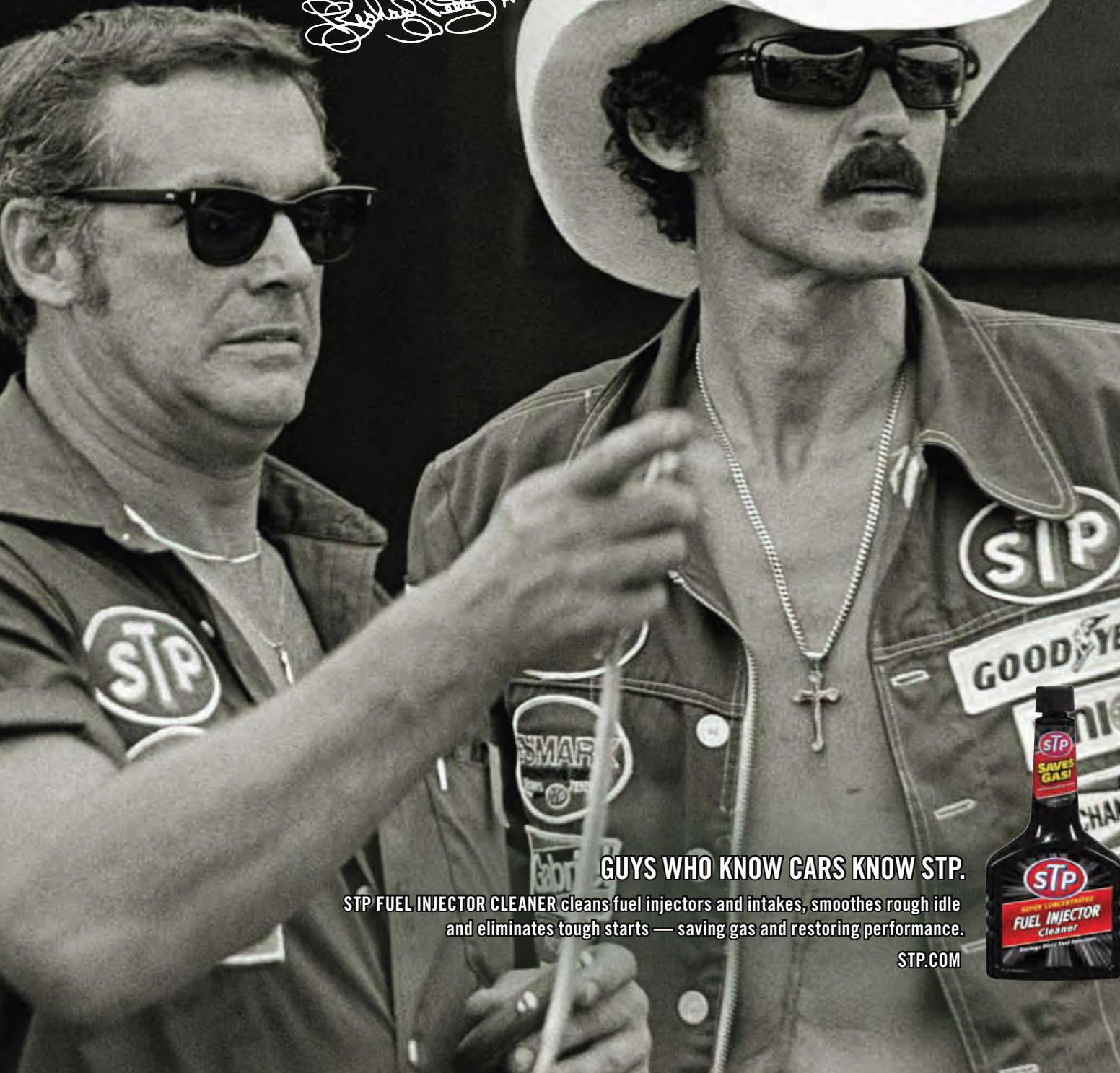

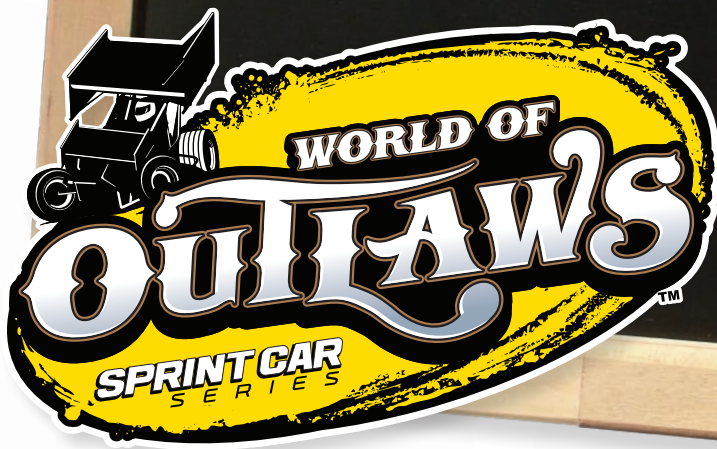

Who Are The World of Outlaws?

The World of Outlaws are the premier sanctioning body for winged sprint car racing in the world, and are comprised of sprint car drivers from across the country and the world. The series was founded by the late Ted Johnson in 1978, giving winged sprint car racers somewhere to compete with uniform rules and guaranteed purse money.

How Long Is The Season?

The season traditionally opens in early February in Florida and concludes in early November. The 2010 season will wrap up with the World Finals at The Dirt Track @ Charlotte Motor Speedway in Concord, North Carolina, November 4-5-6. The event will also include the World of Outlaws Late Model Series and Super DIRTcar Series. Races take place from coast-to-coast and on dirt tracks ranging in size from a 1/4-mile to a 5/8-mile. The schedule usually consists of about 85 events and is considered one of the most grueling in all of motorsports.

What Is A Sprint Car?

A World of Outlaws sprint car is a purpose-built open-wheel race car, that must weigh at least 1,375

pounds with the driver in the car. The 410-cubic inch engine is fueled by methanol, and produces approximately 850-horsepower.

Why Is There A Wing On The Top Of The Car?

A large wing on top of the car with sideboards that face opposite directions help to produce a great amount of downforce to help keep the car planted on the track and turn in the corners. The wings also help to absorb energy in the case of the car getting airborne in an accident. Top wings became prominent in the early 1970's. Sprint cars also are equipped with nose wings.

Where Do The World of Outlaws Race?

The series races from coast-to-coast. Some of the most well-known tracks on the circuit include: Eldora Speedway in Ohio, Knoxville Raceway in Iowa, Silver Dollar Speedway in California, and Williams Grove Speedway in Pennsylvania. The schedule usually consists of about 85 nights of racing, including preliminary and A-Feature events.

Why Are The Cars Pushed To Start?

Sprint cars do not have starters in them, so push

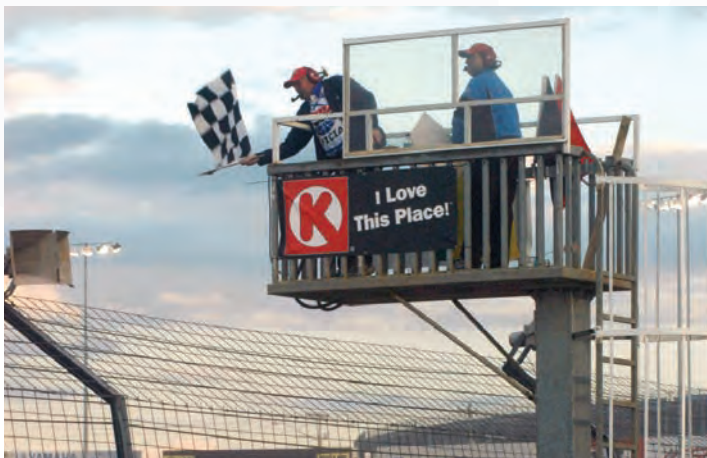
trucks are used to fire the engine and get the car in-gear. A sprint car only has an in/out direct drive, no reverse gear.

What Drivers Began Their Careers With The World of Outlaws?

Dave Blaney, the 1995 series champion, who now races in the NASCAR Sprint Cup and Nationwide series. Kraig Kinser, 20-time champion Steve Kinser's son. Kraig was the 2004 series Rookie of the Year, and raced in the NASCAR Nationwide and Craftsman Truck Series before returning to the World of Outlaws in 2008. Kasey Kahne, who drives in the NASCAR Sprint Cup and Nationwide Series, and also owns the cars driven by Joey Saldana and Craig Dollansky. Two-time NASCAR Sprint Cup champion Tony Stewart owns the cars driven by Donny Schatz and Kraig Kinser.

How Much Does The Winner Of A World of Outlaws Event Earn?

The winner's share of the purse depends on the racing program. Generally, a winner will collect \$10,000 but in some cases a winner will pocket as much as \$12,000, \$20,000, \$25,000, \$30,000 or even \$50,000.



THE FLAGS

A flagman at World of Outlaws events has six flags that can be waved throughout the night to convey information to the drivers.

- A **GREEN FLAG** signifies a start or restart of a race event.
- A **YELLOW FLAG** will wave for caution on the track, requiring drivers to immediately slow down.
- A **RED FLAG** indicates all racing must stop immediately, often times because the racing surface has become unsafe or so safety personnel can quickly attend to an accident.
- A **BLACK FLAG** is waved to tell a driver to take his or her car off the track, and can wave because a driver has committed an infraction or because there is a possible problem with the car requiring inspection by an official or crew member.
- A **WHITE FLAG** is waved to signify the leader is entering the final lap of a race.
- A **CHECKERED FLAG** is waved when the first car crosses the finish line. All cars in World of Outlaws competition are fitted with transponders for electronic scoring so while the checkered flag might wave on a close finish, the official result is determined by computers.

IT'S SHOW TIME!

Donny Schatz edged Jason Meyers by only 19 points to win the 2009 World of Outlaws Sprint Car Series championship — Schatz's fourth title in a row and the closest finish in series history. With several changes for 2010, every night will be an unpredictable fierce battle to the checkered flag all the way to the World Finals in November.

A New Season

There are 17 drivers starting the tour this season with the World of Outlaws. They will compete coast-to-coast for the largest point fund in short track racing, but first they must conquer some new twists and turns for 2010.

One of the most visible changes to World of Outlaws racing is the switch to Goodyear tires. The tire that has carried the most drivers to World of Outlaws championships, Goodyear returns to the series and is presenting a midseason point fund in 2010 that will be distributed after the Don Martin Memorial Silver Cup Twins on July 20 at Lernerville Speedway.

The series also has the fans in mind. World of Outlaws officials have introduced a few twists to spice up the night. Foremost on the list is bringing back double file restarts, which the World of Outlaws pioneered in the 1970s. Each restart will be double file, with the leader picking the line — inside or outside — they want to restart in, with the rest of the field filling in behind two-by-two. It creates breathtaking action on the track.

Also on the docket in 2010 will be an inversion in the Dash, putting the faster cars at least a row back and in some instances two, three or four rows back. The first- and second-place finishers in each heat race will again qualify for the Dash along with the fastest two drivers from time trials who qualified for the A-main but were not first or second in the heat race. Those drivers will be lined up by their qualifying times to determine the Dash lineup, with a fan then drawing a 4, 6 or 8 "pill" for the Dash inversion. The finish of the dash will determine the Top-10 starting positions in the A-main in a three and four heat race program, and the Top-12 spots in a five heat program.

"The tires, the format, the double file restarts, that's all good for our sport," said Kasey Kahne Racing's Joey Saldana. "Whatever we can do to

put on a better show for the fans is great. We have had some great racing the last few years and it should be just as tough in 2010."

Changes On The Track

Highlighting the drivers back on the tour in 2010 is four-time and defending series champion Donny Schatz, who is beginning his fourth season at Tony Stewart Racing. Schatz moved into the Top-Five on the World of Outlaws all-time win list last season and became just the second driver to win four consecutive series title. The only other driver to accomplish that feat is 20-time series champion Steve Kinser, who will be Schatz's teammate this year.

"To have a teammate like Steve Kinser, what else could you ask for," Schatz said. "He is the King. There are no ifs, ands or buts about it. To have



him under the Tony Stewart Racing banner is pretty cool. We're glad to have him. I'm glad to get to race along with him. We're still going to have to be on each other on the track and race each other, but now we have a closer affiliation. When they told me they were going to him I thought, 'Wow, man there is nothing you can say about that.' He is the premier driver in our sport and I'm glad to be a part of it."

For Kinser, it will mark the first time since 1994 he has driven for anyone other than his own team on the World of Outlaws trail. He's not getting out of the car owner business, though, as his Steve Kinser Racing will field the 11k car for his son, Kraig. Steve Kinser opens the 2010 campaign with 552 career A-Feature wins with the World of Outlaws to go along with his 20 championships. He is back to feeling 100 percent following surgery in November to fix a bulging disc in his neck.

"We made a little bit of a swap on race cars," Kinser said. "It's something that Tony Stewart Racing and Steve Kinser Racing decided on. Kraig will drive my car and I'll drive the car that he drove for Tony last year. We're trying to make it a win-win situation for Kraig, for myself and for Tony. I think we have a pretty good combination going."

After winning a series-high 20 races last year, Joey Saldana returns to the No. 9 for Kasey Kahne Racing with Willie Kahne as his crew chief. Saldana became just the fifth different driver in series history last year to win at least 20 A-Feature events in a single season, joining Steve Kinser, Sammy Swindell, Doug Wolfgang and Mark Kinser.

The championship runner-up last year, Meyers takes aim at his first title after winning 10 times last year and coming up just 19 points short. He has his entire team intact from 2009 and opened a new shop in Brownsburg, Ind., to make the California-headquartered team more at ease this year.

Danny Lasoski, the 2001 World of Outlaws champion, is back for his second year in the No. 6 machine for Parsons Motorsports, with Jason Sides back in the saddle after turning in a career-year in 2009 that saw him win twice and finish fifth in points.

Craig Dollansky has a new look this year as he will be in the No.7 for Big Game Motorsports based out of his home state of Minnesota.

Hall of Famer Jac Haudenschild is on the road again this year, as well as 2008 Rookie of the Year, Lucas Wolfe and defending rookie titlist Brian Ellenberger. Chad Kemenah and Sam Hafertepe Jr. both return to the road this year after starting last year with the series.

A leg injury to Cody Darrah before the season started in Florida reduced the Kevin Gobrecht Rookie of the Year Award battle to Ben Gregg, Tim Kaeding and Toni Lutar.

Racing From Coast To Coast

During the nine-month season, the World of Outlaws will compete about 80 times from coast-to-coast, along with two separate stops in Canada at three tracks north of the border. The season concludes with the Fourth Annual World of Outlaws World Finals at The Dirt Track @ Charlotte Motor Speedway, which will this year features the World of Outlaws Sprint Car Series, the World of Outlaws Late Model Series and the Super DIRTcar Big-Block Modifieds.
